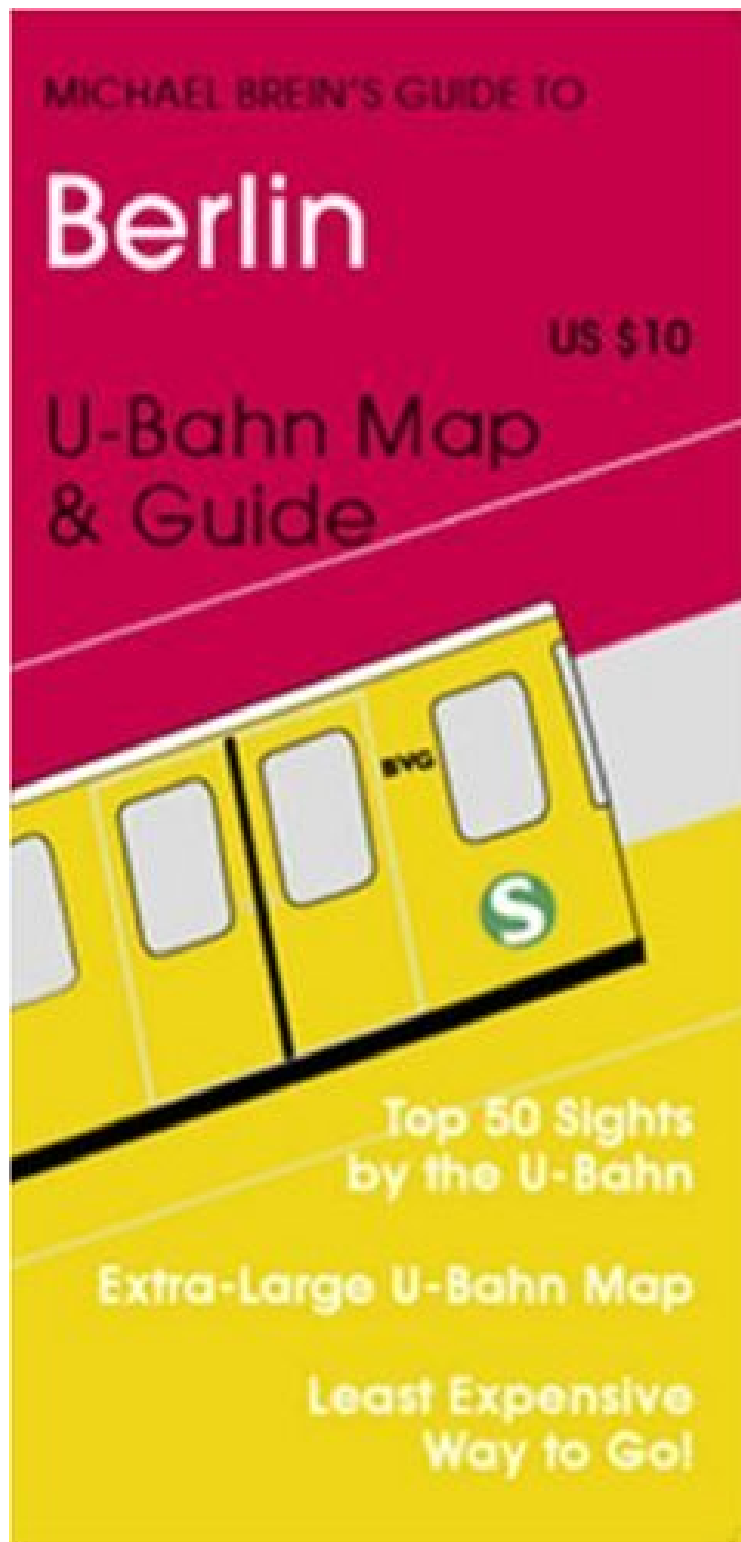

Back has brief description of points of interest, and a 2"x3" map of each point. You still need to know what you want to visit based on prior research. U-Bahn maps for BMW Museum, Hofbrauhaus, Englischer Garten, Marienplatz and other locations are shown. Worth the cost.
