They don't replace a general guide book such as Fodor's, Lonely Planet, Rick Steves, and the like. But for culture and history, they simply can't be beat. And for the volumes with walking tours, you'll see everything worth seeing on those tours. We recently spent a week in Chicago, and we relied entirely on this book. It

does not have exhaustive lists of restaurants or hotels, but everything it suggests is carefully selected.
