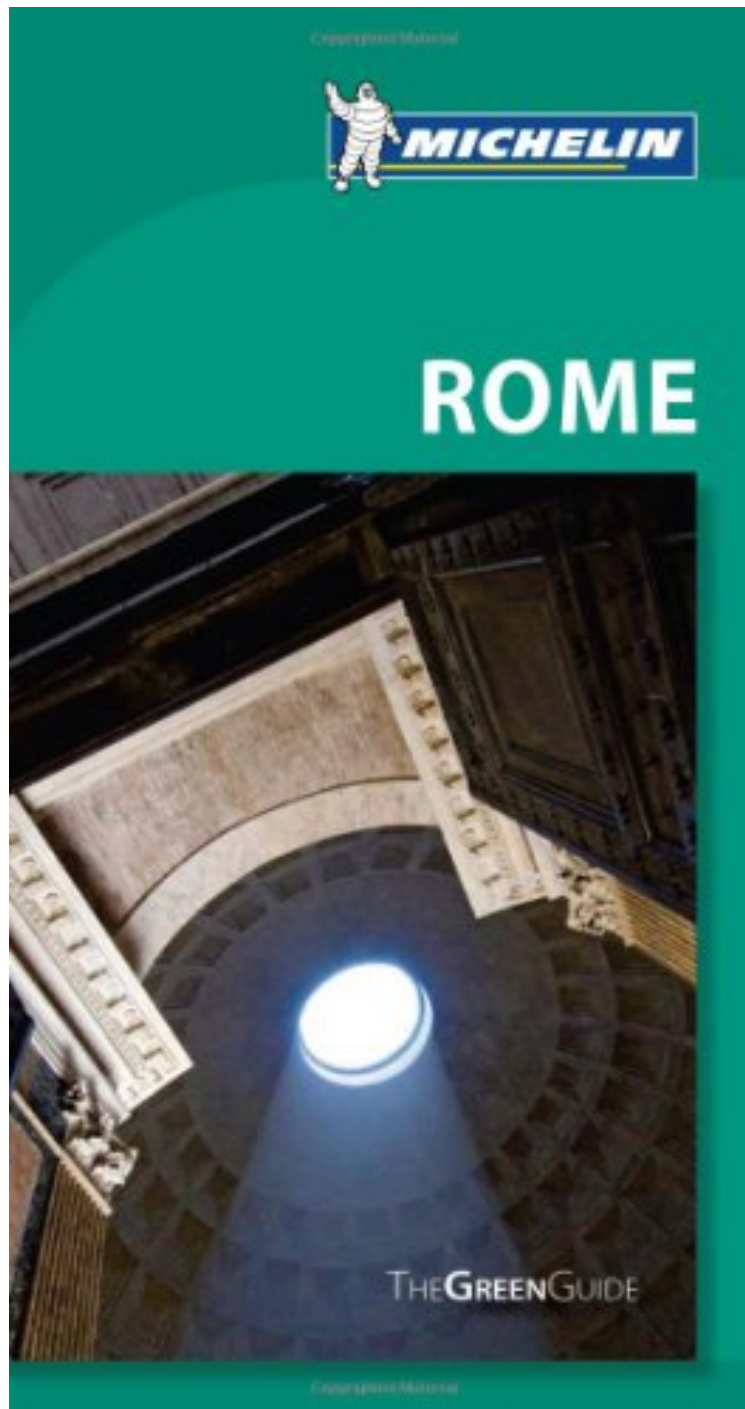

It has a huge amount of information on so many places in Rome and organizes them by neighborhood, which is the most logical way to organize a guide to Rome. It also ranks sights and attractions by one to three stars, which is helpful, especially for churches, to plan and decide what to visit, plus it gives a lot of interesting cultural and historical information about them. There are so many incredible places in Rome and I found the presentation and explanations and maps to be extremely helpful for getting around Rome and deciding how to spend my days there. The book is jam-packed with information and especially good for all the museums in Rome, with layouts of the museums and explanations of the most important works. As an M.A. student in the classics, I found the guide extremely useful, especially for the lesser known but just as impressive museums for classical art, such as the Palazzo Massimo, the Palazzo Altemps, the Via Giulia Museum of Etruscan Art, etc. The star rating system it uses was also great in finding some real gems in Rome few people visit, such as the Museum of Musical Instruments, near the monastery-hotel I stayed at, which I would never have discovered on my own. It is not as useful for finding hotels and restaurants, but these days most people use online resources, such as TripAdvisor, for that. There is another guide, the Red Guide, that gives info about hotels and restaurants, but I didn't buy it and had no real need for it, having already made reservations with online resources. Whether you are interested in classical, Renaissance, or modern Rome, this guide is excellent, and I highly recommend it.

A friend insisted that I buy this guide. What a waste--except for the history section. The same area of Rome is referred to in several different ways; the map descriptors don't match the text. Example: Campo dei Fiori-Michelin Map 38L 10-11--and there is no such map in the book--you are apparently supposed to know that you must buy a "Michelin Map" to use the book. (Although there are two poorly labeled maps in the book.) I can't understand where Michelin gets its reputation from. Maybe there's a club you have to join and they give you the secret code to using the guides. Just ordered the Eyewitness Guide which I have used before--and a city map.
