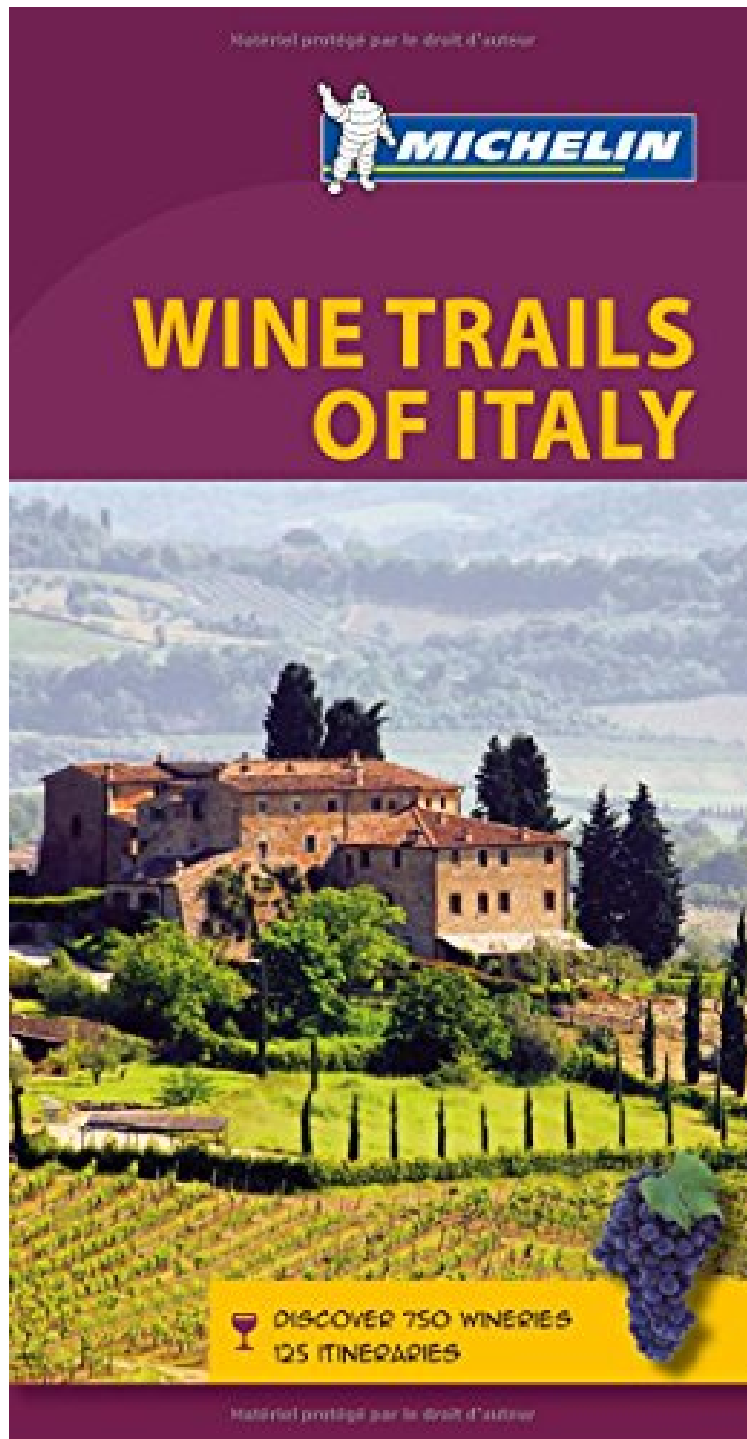

While I appreciate the details of the wineries and wine production in each region, I certainly expected a book with better actual itineraries and actual maps of some of the wine trails in Italy. The maps are a major disappointment -- a single map per region, routes are not marked, and the region is overlaid in purple that makes it harder to read the actual contents. Trying to match up the single map for each region with the described (in text) itineraries is pointless and frustrating. Some of the individual city maps are better, but those can be found in almost any guide book. Add in the full-page advertising mixed in throughout, and I have to say that this simply isn't up to snuff with the other Michelin guides I have seen. While it's not entirely useless -- the database of visitable wineries is appreciated -- as an actual travel planner or travel guide this is absolutely not worth it to me.
