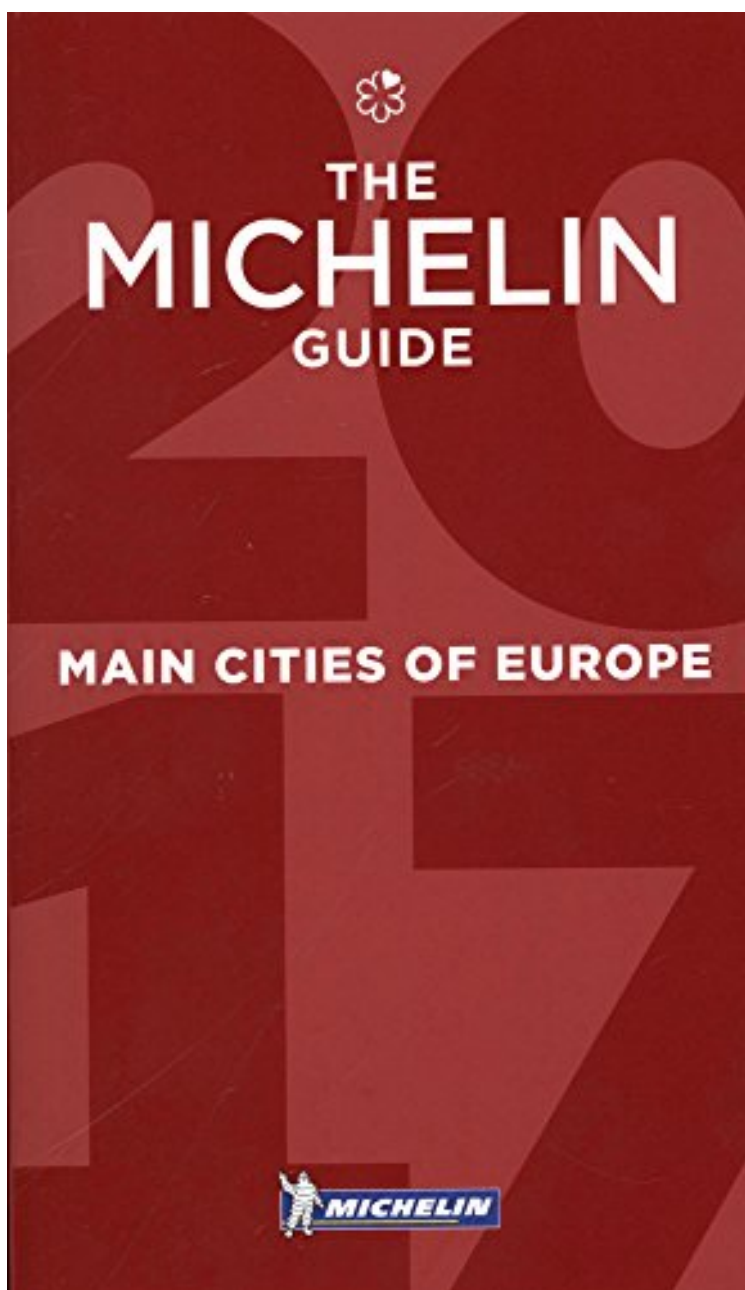

By JJ At one time, this was an invaluable travel aid and I have bought it each year as the price went up and the content decayed into a jumble of incorrect facts or biased opinions. The guide is too big to easily carry in my carry on bag and, as more and more cities have been added, there is a notable decline in the usefulness. Of top importance is the Michelin claim that they judge restaurants solely on the quality of the cuisine. What's more, they tend to rate based on some vague value scale that, in my actual experience, has more to do with flair, glitz and theater than on actual quality of the food served. Great restaurants are often ignored while the houses with a circus in the lobby or a hundred cooks in the kitchen still get top ratings. Finally, the book is out of balance with France getting the biggest share. Yes, Michelin is French, but if I wanted all of this information about France I would buy the France guide! The book is no longer valuable for me and like other supposedly objective rating systems, (AAA, MobileGuide, Zagat, etc) has descended to a level that makes ratings and conclusions about properties very suspect. 1 of 1 people found the following review helpful.
