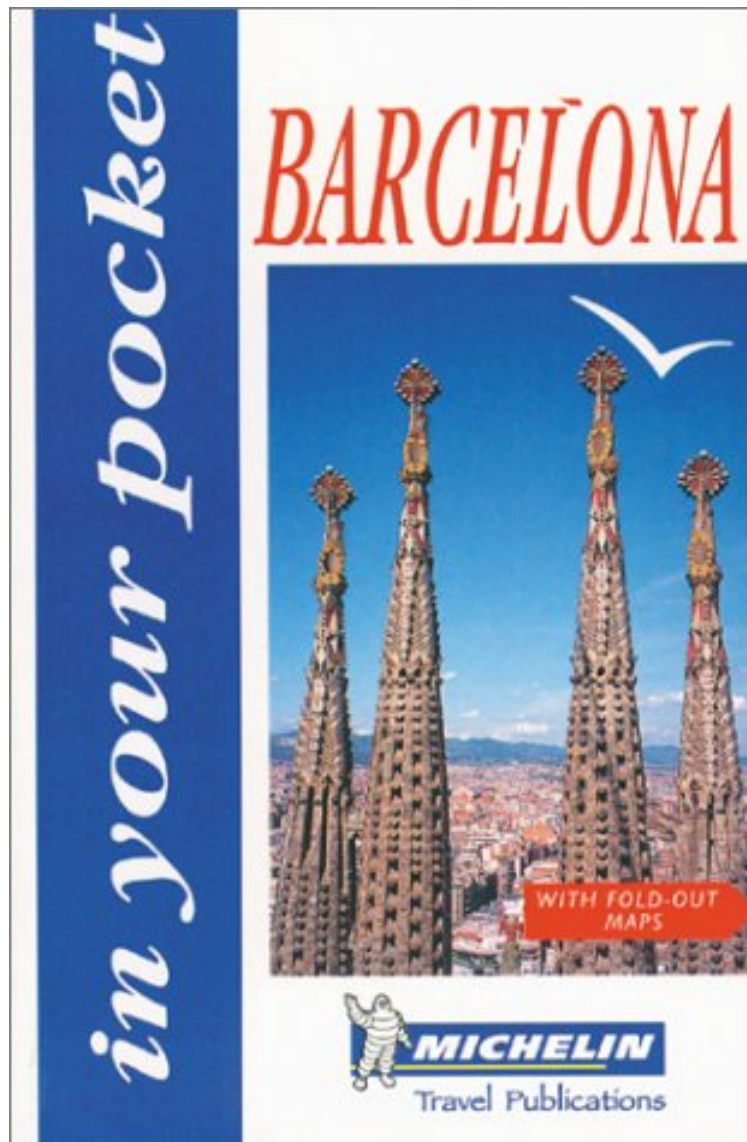

It seems that the most popular guide book is actually Eyewitness Travel Guides Barcelona and Catalonia. I had purchased the Eyewitness Travel Guide on Spain and found that even though the section on Barcelona was small it was extremely helpful with diagrams, descriptions and small easy to understand maps. This Michelin guide has listed only a very few restaurants in Barcelona which is quite disappointing since there are a gazillion very good ones. Overall, this guide gave a very broad overview and oversimplified what there is to see and do in Barcelona and is really not particularly useful for the traveler.
