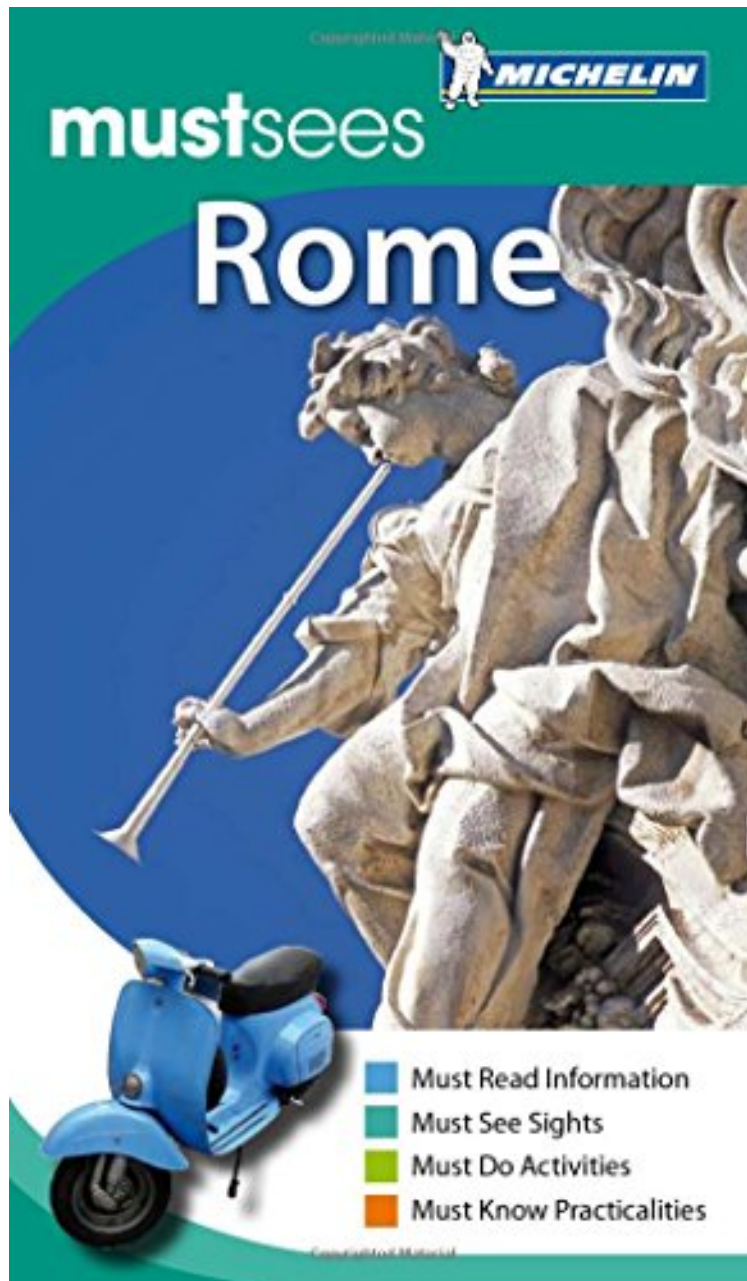

In my opinion this guide is too short to be a main info source and full of useless info/lacking necessary details as a pocket guide. It has very little floor plans of the sights, no info on the admission prices at all only very brief descriptions of highlights and open hours. There are very good walks with maps around all the major sightseeing areas but it was not what I was looking for. Guide includes a lot of general info on pre- trip planning, which is described in very general terms and absolutely useless once you are already in Rome. Restaurants don't have map so it is quite impossible to know where they are located. Same thing is with hotels. And who needs a hotels list in a pocket guide unless you are extremely spontaneous and each afternoon need to decide where you going to spend a night.
