What a fun little book! I typically try to take notes during vacations. I refer to them for my photo captions and when reviewing hotels or restaurants, and keeping track of spending. I usually also have a folder going with printed out itineraries, but this time I transferred some useful details into the book. This is great for a longer stay in a city like Barcelona. We were there for a week, and unless you are a very wordy note-taker, a shorter stay might not make the book a good buy- unless you wanted to add other notes from other cities to this book. If you haven't figured it out yet, this is sort of a do-it-yourself travel journal. The map pages, while small, were very detailed. The size was excellent- would fit into a purse or pocket without taking much space. There were 3 attached book marks, and a useful elastic to hold a page or the book shut. There was a pocket at the back for loose items. There were stickers to add your own labels to the tabbed pages at the back of the book. There were plenty of blank pages- this is where I entered my daily notes. You can make notes ahead of time to remind yourself of museum opening hours or costs, metro lines to take, and pertinent info so that you don't have to lug a guide book around. Entering some airline details ahead of the trip proved helpful at the end of our trip, as we had a travel delay and needed to contact the airline, and as it was at the end of our trip, the full-size travel folder was packed pretty deep in my bag at that point. There was really nothing to dislike about this book, other than a wish that there were some blank general travel ones with the same set of page info. If you have never journaled or taken notes while traveling before, this may be a bit intimidating. But if you do- get this book! What a great addition it made to a fabulous week in Barcelona!

When I first received my copy of the Barcelona Moleskin City Book, I emailed the seller and asked if perhaps I had received a bad press run, because the typography on the first few pages was really faint and difficult to read. The response was that apparently the designer had chosen a lighter gray color ink for pages that contained

information such as Measurements and Conversions, Metro Station Index, Transport, etc. As a result, you have to tilt the book to catch the light properly in order to read the entries, not exactly something you really want to be struggling with while standing on a street corner looking lost. Fortunately the text on the maps is easier to read-- but many of smaller placas and carrers in the Old City are not identified so you will be wandering around lost, even with your these maps in hand. Finally, the book is 3 1/2 inches by 5 1/2 inches, meaning that while it fits into your pocket, you might want to bring a magnifying glass along if you expect to read any of the 14 sectional maps for the city. I would have preferred something a bit larger-- perhaps the next size up moleskin book. I'll probably carry it with me, now that I own it, but I will also buy a real map. BTW, the exterior stripe-- which is green for this book-- is nothing more than a removable paper wrapper.

The first guidebook you write yourself. Whether you are viewing Gaud's architecture, relaxing on the city's many beaches or watching a football game, the Moleskine City Notebook Barcelona is a trusty travel companion. The Key Map summarizes the overall city layout, showing the sequence and location of the 12 zone maps and the 2 maps of the city center enlargement. Map of the metro system and list of stations, plus the alphabetical street index of the zone maps. Blank pages for jotting down notes and recording your thoughts, stories and memories. 32 removable sheets for loose notes and exchanging messages. 12 translucent sticky sheets for tracing your routes and sharing itineraries. A 96-page tabbed archive for collecting everything that matters most and keeping it at your fingertips. The first 6 tabs are printed; the others await your personalization with the enclosed adhesive labels. Each pocket sized Moleskine City Notebook is thread bound and has a cardboard bound cover with rounded corners, acid free paper, three bookmarks, an elastic closure and an expandable inner pocket that contains the Moleskine history.
