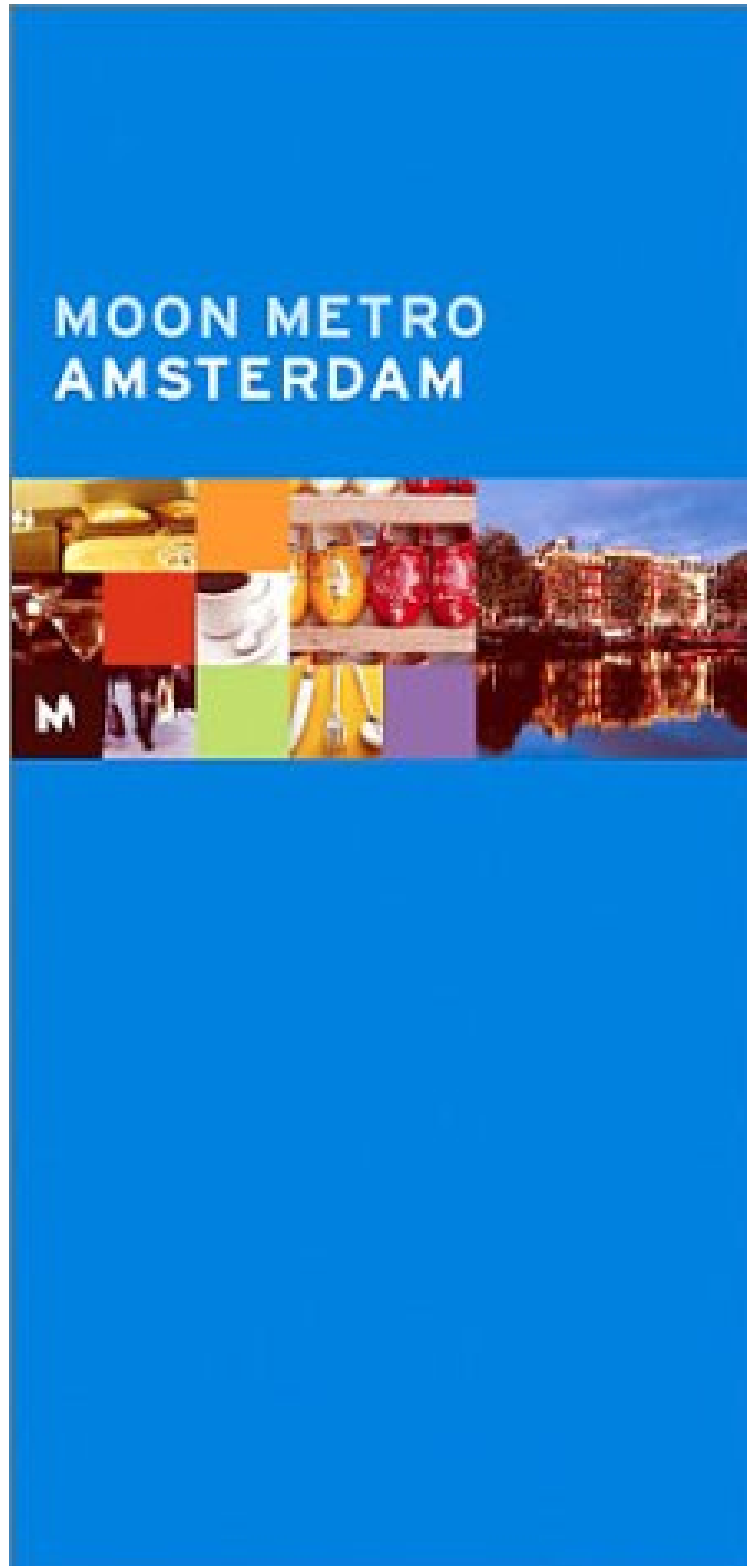

Few visitors make it to this neighborhood because it's not even mentioned in most guides. The book also tells you where you can take an excellent small-boat tour of the canals that's completely different from the usual tourist boats, as well as places to get great street food, like hot stroopwafels (crispy caramel-filled cookies) and the best frites (french fries) in town.
