The authors have even included a number of interesting day trip excursions from Barcelona and a small section at the back with information on hotels and restaurants in each section of the city described earlier. Not a Frommers or Lonely Planet type guide with info about the location of the local hostels, railway station, bus terminal etc. You can research other sources to decide on a hotel or the latest chic restaurant and use this book to plan your daytime excursions to the various city quarters.
