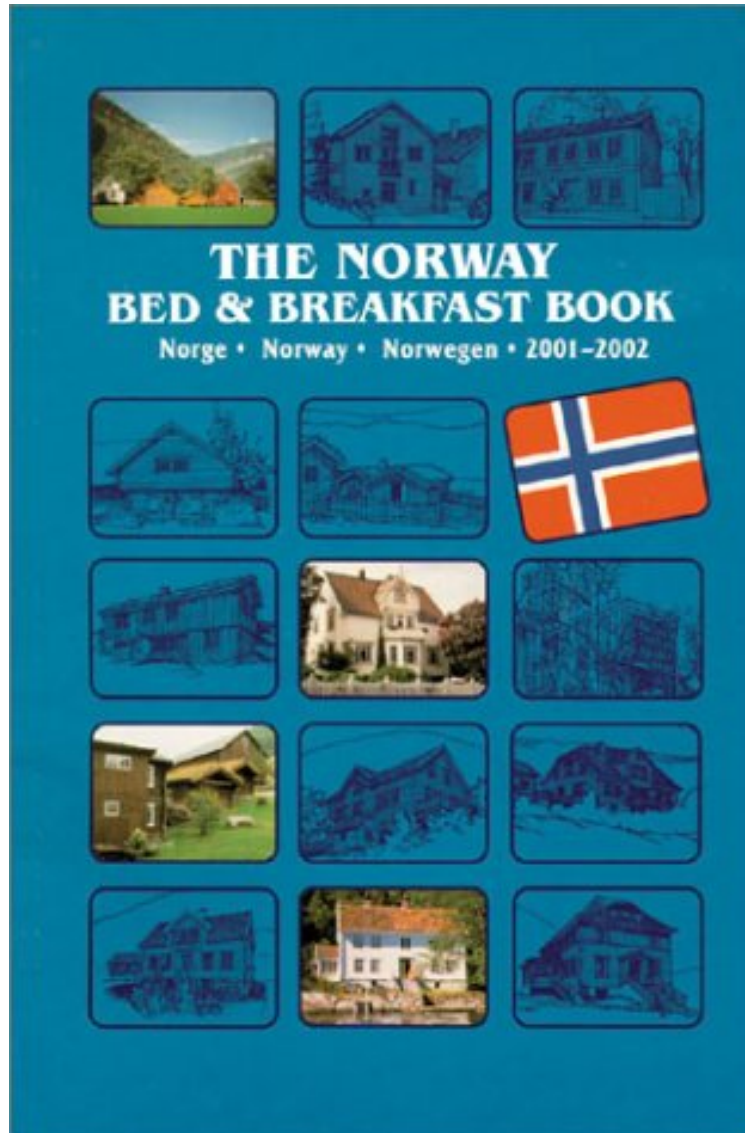

Ronneberg Gard was an unfriendly place up a nondescript hill with no signs or advice and we just gave up and left. And I speak Norwegian. Petrine's Gestgiveri, at Norddal, had one grubby room available when we arrived, with 2 low sloppy beds and a bathroom a long walk away. I am sure they had better rooms with advance reservation, to be fair. In many other towns on our West country tour, there was no listing in the area. This book offers much too little to justify buying it or carrying it to Norway.
