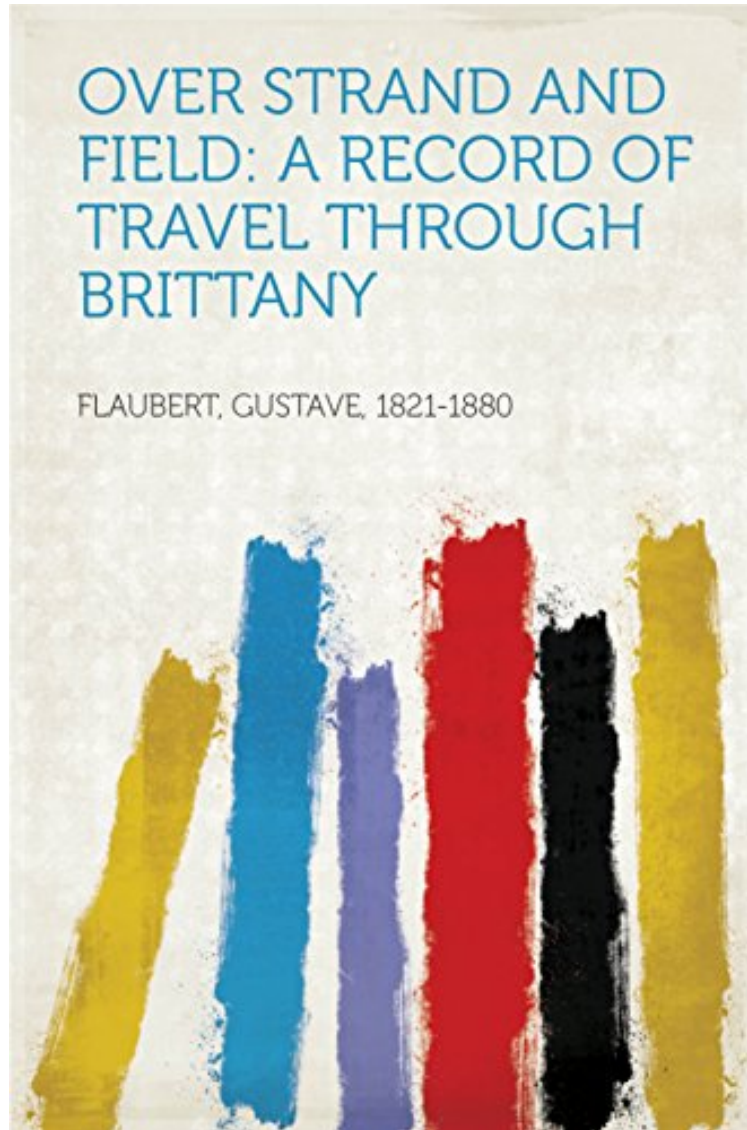

His work has been widely adapted for the stage and screen. Flaubert died in 1880.
