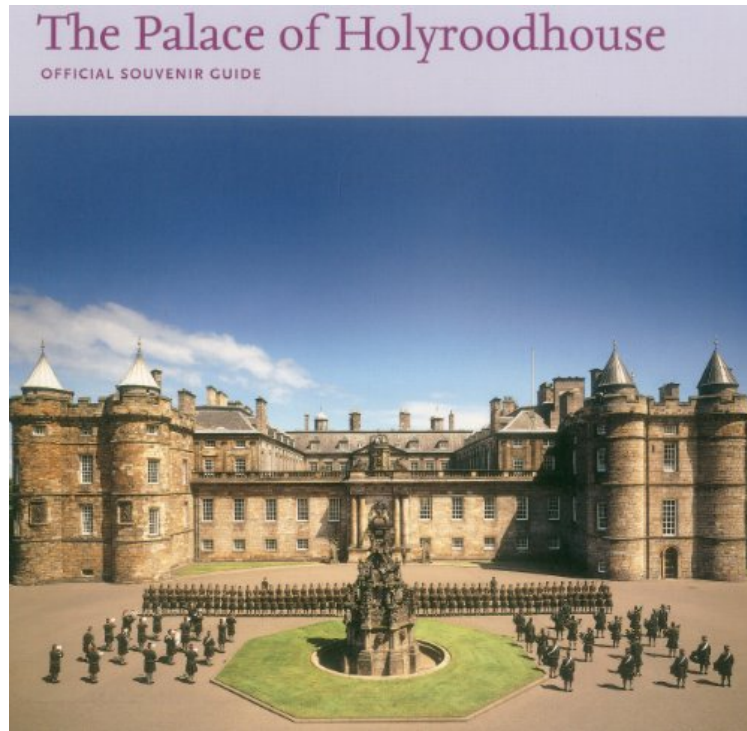

From the time of the visit of George IV in 1822, it became one of the foremost attractions of the Scottish capital.
