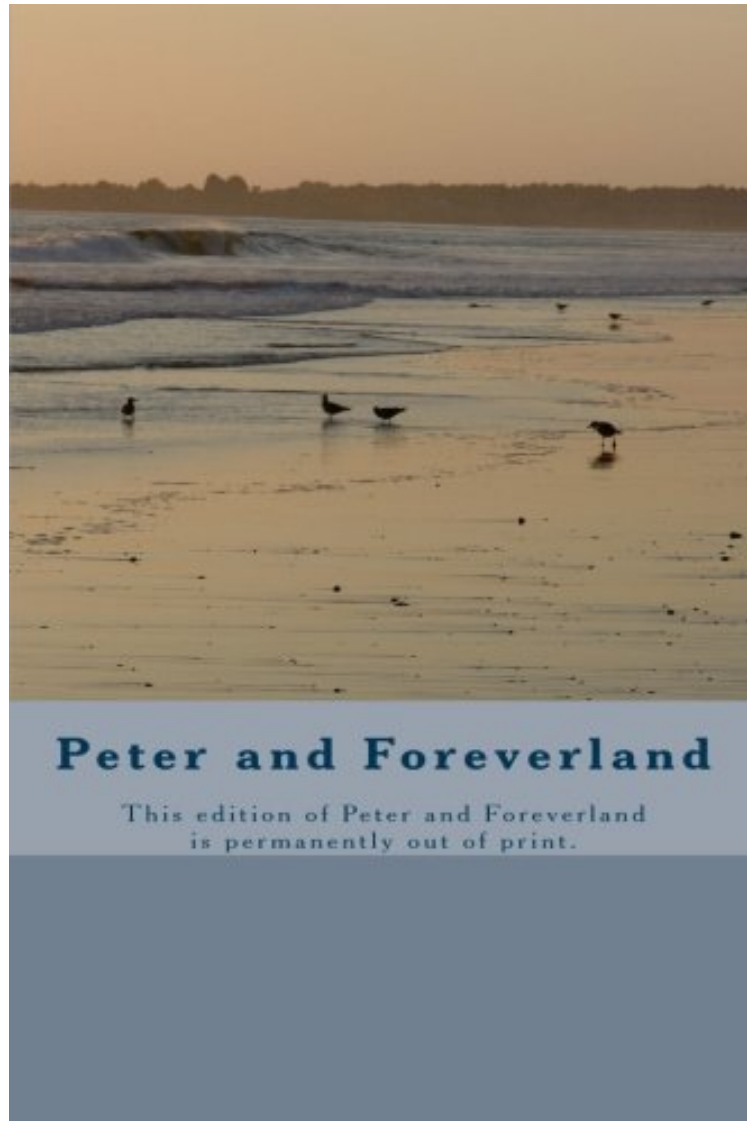

It's a great spin on the traditional Peter Pan, and a nice alternative to the Harry Potter books!Three foster-home kids are chosen by a mysterious Lady to fly to Foreverland with Peter and Tink and begin their training that will bring them back and forth between Foreverland and the Mainland. Their assignment is to unmask the real Captain

Hook. Peter and Foreverland is an allegory: Peter is the Apostle Peter, keeper of the Keys to the Kingdom. Tinker Bell is Peter's former Guardian Angel (former, because in Foreverland you don't need guardian Angels as you do on the Mainland). Pixies are actually Angels (who live on the nearby Island of Lysander, which is ruled by Michael the Archangel). The Natives are the Saints and Martyrs. Tiger Lily is Joan of Arc. The Chief is Paul. There are Elijah Horses that fly, Scorpusts that are giant half-scorpions, half-locusts (right out of the Book of the Apocalypse; used for the kids' training purposes in the Arena.). The mermaids are Hermaids, beautiful hermit-like women who live among the Foreverland Lagoons. And then there's Captain Hook. Who exactly is he in the story? There lies the plot. Just who really is the bad guy in all of today's movies, books and TV shows? Who or what is the real Captain Hook and why is his true identity always kept hidden? I don't want to spoil it. The writing style is enjoyable and fast moving. It brings out the kid in us all to see two brothers (12 and 9) and their seven-year-old sister deal with the realities of heaven and hell, angels and demons... in a light-hearted read. Finally, in Part 1, they return to the Mainland and begin their quest to reveal the real Captain Hook.
