The book is a bit outdated. It was written in 1999, and many things have changed. It mentions that the pope is John Paul II, who sometimes visits his homeland. Also, it talks about people living in apartments in the city. It says that two or three families might share a bathroom. That is no longer true. Aside from those issues, the book is colorful and informative.

Poland offers a little bit of history, but the majority of the book looks at modern life and includes such topics as the importance of Catholicism, Polish food, education, and family life. Costa Rica also includes a short history section that details the landing of Columbus in 1502 and the indigenous population and culture. The rest of the book discusses such subjects as the rain forest, soccer, and life in the city. Useful glossaries and pronunciation guides will help students with unfamiliar foreign words.
