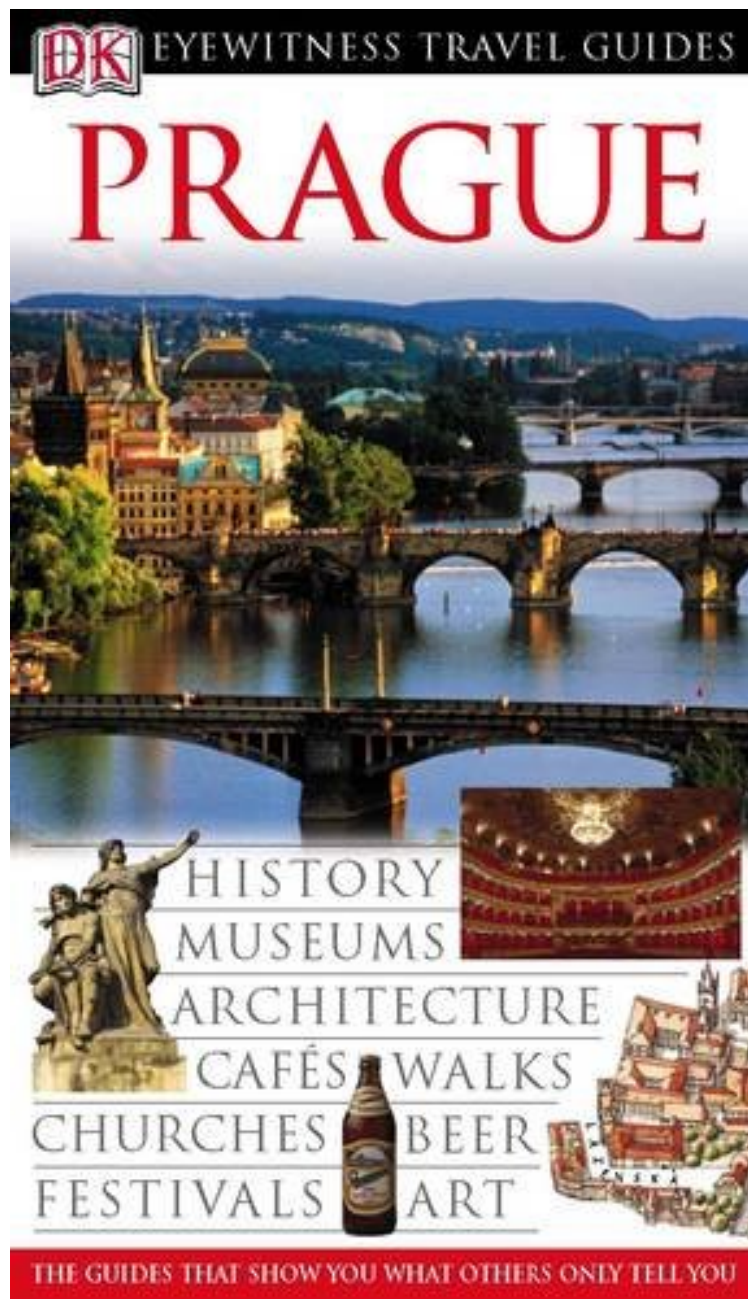

High Quality, Heavy Slick Paperback. The Flexi-bound, was a lower cost, shipping cost was the same, as if it had been shipped from US. The thing I like about the FLEXIBOUND IS that it can be coaxed to lay flat open. This works great for me, as I usually use 2 books (normally a Rick Steves or Baedekers) along with the DK's and the fact it lays flat, is helpful for comparing and research I do in advance of a trip. Overall, I like the DK Eyewitness Guides for their Beautiful Color Photos / Illustrations. For me, photos/illustrations give me an instant knowledge, of YES, I DO WANT TO SEE THIS.
