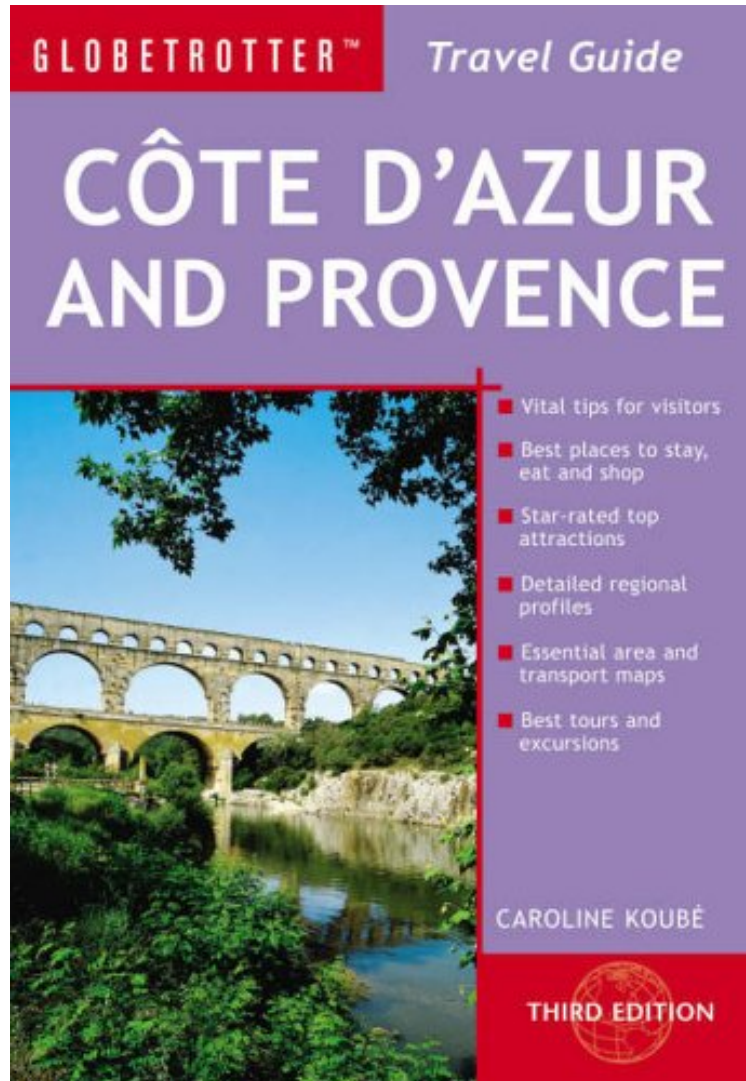

Hedges I have been to France several times, and while I love Paris, I absolutely adore the Côte d'Azur. The Globetrotter Travel Guide by Caroline Koubé is a very useful book for considering your options on the French

Riviera. Nice and Monaco have been my two enduringly favorite destinations in the area, but there is so much more to explore, and I encourage you to use this book for planning a trip anywhere in the region. It is filled with details that make understanding the area easy, and with maps that are generally useful. The maps contained in the book itself are in color but are extremely tiny, making them not especially useful for navigation, though they are fine for general planning or orientation. The book comes with a very nice foldout map of the area which is extremely useful for navigation, is legible, and shows just the right amount of detail for travelers. On the opposite side there are several good detailed maps of cities in the region (Nice, Marseille, Aix-en-Provence, etc.) I found the information in the book to be very helpful, and it is small enough to easily accompany you while you are out enjoying southern France (though not small enough to fit in a pocket.) There is now a newer edition available, and I always recommend getting the latest printing possible. If you are planning on a trip to the Côte d'Azur and Provence this will serve you well.

The Packs are excellent value, including both a guidebook and a softcover version of the fold-out Globetrotter map of the region, in a printed plastic wallet.
